Being Imaginative & Health and self-care – Can you come up with a song or a rap that highlights the importance of washing your hands and how to make sure you wash them properly? Make sure its 20 seconds and record yourself so your grown-ups can upload it to Tapestry!

Communication and Listening – Can cut out a frame from a piece of paper. Look through the frame, look high and look low. What things can you see? Do any of the things look similar? Use different vocabulary to describe things you see to an adult, can they guess what you are looking at?



Literacy – Can you make a card for one of your friends, telling them all about your Easter holidays? Remember you must do this on your own! Use your sound mat and phonics learning to help you. Upload it to Tapestry so we can see it.

Physical Development – Take part in Joe Wicks PE sessions on YouTube everyday at 9am for the whole of this week.

Maths – The Easter Bunny wants to know if you can hop further than him!

1. Draw out a number line (indoor or outdoor with chalk or paper)
2. How far can you hop/jump like the Eater Bunny. Just use one jump or hop at a time. Challenge your family members to do the same. Can you record it on paper?
3. After this try jumping twice and creating addition number sentences with the two numbers you land on
