<u>Mission Timeline</u>


Launch: 30th July 2020 from Cape Canaveral Air Force Station in Florida.

Landing: 18th February 2021 at the site of an ancient river delta in a lake that once filled Jezero Crater.

Time: To spend at least 1 Mars year (2 Earth years) exploring the landing site region.

Main Job: To seek signs of ancient life and collect samples of rock and regolith (broken rock and soil) for possible return to Earth.
