- ▶ Easter, Pentecost and Mission, St. Peter and St. Paul and Sacraments




- We have a Stone Age workshop on the school field on Monday 22nd September.

- Please don't forget to pay for these trips on SCOpay and return the consent form.







Spelling

Children will be given activities to help them practise their spellings rules for that given week.

Vocabulary

Children will be given a list of words and should try and use these words in conversations with their family to expand and deepen their vocabulary.

<u>Maths</u>

Children will be given a range of activities that cover various areas of the Maths curriculum.

Home Reading Journal

Children will complete a short book review on a book that they have read. At least one entry should be made every 2 weeks (3 over the course of a half term). Book reviews should be signed off by a parent.

<u>Library</u>

Year Three library slot with class – 30 minutes on Wednesday afternoon.
