- ▶ Peru **and** Rivers

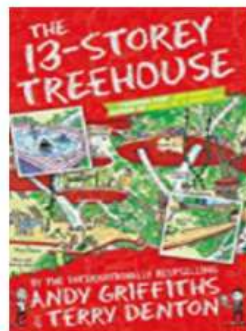
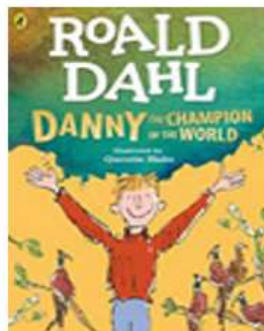
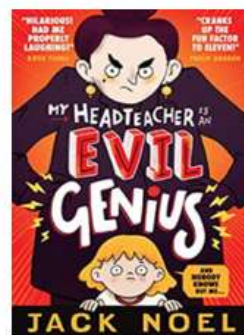
Summer Term:

What can you do at home to support your child in Year 3?

- ▶ Regular routines and a good nights sleep.

 - ▶ Number bonds work
 - ▶ Times tables (inverse included)

Home learning

Spelling

- ▶ Children will be given activities to help them practise their spellings rules for that given week.

Vocabulary

- ▶ Children will be given a list of words and should try and use these words in conversations with their family to expand and deepen their vocabulary.

Maths

- ▶ Children will be given a range of activities that cover various areas of the Maths curriculum.

Reading

- ▶ Children will be asked to complete a book review every two weeks about a book they have just finished or one they have started to read.



Library

Year Three library slots are 30 minutes on Wednesday afternoon.

Please make sure any borrowed library books are brought back in so children can use this time to choose a new one. Children can now take out 2 books at a time.
