



Analyse

- Why would ordinary people choose to be heroes? What makes them special?

Evaluate

- Who is your favourite hero? Why? What is the difference between them and you?

Create

- Create an outfit for a superhero. What should a cape be made from? What materials can you use? How can you keep them dry/safe?

Apply

- What could you do to become a superhero in your house? Could you be Mr Dishwasher, Captain Carrier, Super-Kind-Girl, Happy Hero or invent your own hero alias? Write about your adventures and the difference you make to the people around you!

Understand

- Where might a hero live? You could use a shoebox and create the ideal home for a superhero e.g. Elastic Man's house may have a jelly bed!
- What heroes do you know of in our local community? Do you know any lifeboat crew members, fire fighters or guide dogs?

Remember

- Find out about your favourite hero. This could be someone like The Hulk or Elsa, or could be a local hero like a nurse.
- Tell your parents what a superhero does all day!
